Call to Order Paul Harrison, Chair of the Senate Nominating Committee, called the

meeting to order at 10:01 am.

Adoption of The agenda was adopted as amended by general consent.

Agenda Amendment: Minutes postponed to next meeting.

AP5: Deans

The Clerk asked for clarity on the Committee's position on the alternative process proposed. Members of the Committee discussed and agreed that the Committee did not support the alternative process for reasons for

transparency and ensuring stakeholder participation in the process. The Committee resolved to draft a letter to the Board of Governors and the

Okanagan Senate outlining its concerns.

Chair Senator Menzies assumed the chair.

Academic Diversity and Inclusion Senator Harrison reminded the Committee that there were two proposals being considered to ensure this work was addressed by Senate: a committee (either standing or ad hoc), or amending the terms of reference for all other Senate standing committees to have this integrated diversity

and inclusion considerations in their work.

The Committee discussed if this was premature given the forthcoming external review; Senator Holmes opined that he felt that an external review would recommend a committee and that the Senate should not delay forming one. Senator Menzies spoke in favour of the imbedding these considerations in the work of all other committees rather than having a single committee with the responsibility.

Conflict of

The Clerk senate out the background on the past draft that was circulated to the Senate for comment, noting that the previous draft was not well received by many senators for conflicting reasons: some felt it was too prescriptive, others that it was not prescriptive enough. He suggested reapproaching this work from a principle-based perspective rather than trying

to codify all possible behaviors.

Senator Menzies differentiated between conflicts of interest and purposeful intent, noting that the latter was not required for there to be a conflict that needed to be avoided.
