 - i. "That the Vancouver Senate urges the President and Board of Governors to require all students, staff, and faculty attending, supporting, or delivering in-person classes, tutorials, or laboratories to be fully vaccinated against the COVID-19 virus prior to doing so."
 - ii. "That the Vancouver Senate affirms the need for flexibility for moving individual courses (subject to the approval of heads and directors for department or school-based courses, and deans for those courses offered directly by faculties) on and off line this year according to pedagogical needs until October 22 in accordance with a responsibility to maintain the health and safety of our classrooms and minimize disruptions to course delivery."
