A committee member asked whether students can use courses both towards their graduate degree and the graduate certificate. In response, the proponent confirmed that courses can be counted twice; the requirement to take courses outside of their home department will help to ensure that students take migration courses. J. Iverson confirmed that double-counting courses is allowable under Senate Policy V-128 whereby course credits can be applied towards another course of study, however, not another certificate.
